From Covid-19 Safety Plan: Operational Procedures, Safety & Wellness

Signage	Located at the Entrance, Studios, Common area – Dancers are reminded to maintain physical distancing protocol. Please follow social distancing markings on floors.
Studio Lobby *CLOSED*	Parents are to remain in cars and not onsite in the facility. Appointment only meetings with reception staff are in effect.
Staggered start times	To reduce the number of students moving in and out at one time.
CLASS TIME REDUCED	Class times will be reduced by 10-15 minutes to allow time for students to leave the facility and teachers to sanitize: Floors, Barres, Surfaces, Props and Mats
Building Occupancy & Class Sizes	Building Occupancy: 50 Persons Each studio will be clearly marked with 9’6x9’9 or 9’6 x 8’ boxes for each dancer Maximum Numbers based on these boxes plus teacher: Studio 1 (Pink): 13 Studio 2 (Purple): 12 Studio 3 (Green): 12
Entry to Building and Studios	Before entering the studio, you will need to wash your hands per guidelines or use hand sanitizer that we will have available at the entrance. You will find a hand sanitizing station at the reception desk and upstairs on the wall. Each washroom is equipped with appropriate hand washing techniques on the walls, and antibacterial soap. Hand sanitizer is available in each studio and to be used upon entering and leaving each studio.
Health Checks and Policies	All dancers and instructors are to perform a health check by designated checker before coming into the building. Temperature checks will be done. If there are Covid symptoms the child’s parents will be contacted and the child will be asked to wait in the closed homework room until pick up. Staff will be asked to go home immediately and a sub will take their place. If the symptoms are not Covid based please stay home a week after symptoms are cleared. Anyone with Covid symptoms is asked to remain at home and request testing. In the event of a confirmed Covid exposure you will be notified and a 14-day isolation period will take place in accordance with Fraser Health protocols.
Partner Work	Dancers will not train with partner work in classes. Choreography will be set adhering to social distancing. If the recommendation comes from the Provincial Health Department that partnering is allowed our policy will be reviewed.
No Changing	Dancers should arrive in one outfit suitable for dancing all their classes in. No changing will be permitted
Sanitization	All Studios will be fully disinfected after each class. Bathrooms to be sanitized after usage. Full cleaning and sanitization of facility will take place each night. Individual cubbies will have a placard indicating it has been sanitized. This placard will be removed when in use and only returned upon sanitization.
Water bottles	Dancers will be asked to bring their own water bottle for personal use only. The water station will be closed and no cups or water bottles will be supplied
Limit Personal Items	Students will bring what is only required for class – A Small lululemon, Gift Bag or shoe bag is acceptable to carry required shoes and water bottle. No sharing of items.
Food	Eating will NOT be permitted in any areas of Cameron Dance Academy facility. No access to fridge or microwave. Please eat at home, or in vehicles
Online Classes	*Transference to Zoom classes will take place when mandated closures are in effect. Zoom will be available during the time a student is ill and away from class.
Mandatory Mask Policy *Update*	Ages 2 & Up Staff, Guests and Students are required to wear a face covering in all public indoor settings. Masks are to be worn in all areas of the studio; common spaces and studios while dancing. NB: Exceptions will apply for those with medical reason (i.e. Asthma) when provided with an exemption letter from a Doctor
